OEXMANN ART COMPETITION RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. OBJECT

The object of this competition is to encourage and promote Wiltshire artists and is open to everyone born or living in Wiltshire. The Museum reserves the right to ask prize-winners for proof of birthplace or residence. Entries will be judged by three experienced artists.

2. COMPETITION CATEGORIES

There are 2 Young Persons categories: Ages 6-11 and 12-18 (you must be 18 or under as of 1 October 2024. If you are over 18 after this date then please enter the adult category). There is no charge to enter the Competition in these categories.

3. ENTRIES

Entries can be of any subject matter and can be in any two dimensional medium, i.e. painting, drawing, collage and printmaking but not photography or computer generated. All Young Persons' entries must be UNFRAMED.

3D entries are also accepted. Entries must be original work and the judges will not consider works that reveal copying or plagiarism.

4. SIZE RESTRICTIONS

Ages 6 to 14: up to A3 on card or paper.

Ages 15 to 18: up to A2 on card or paper.

3D entries: 25 cm x 25 cm x 25 cm.

These dimensions are strictly enforced due to limited gallery space.

5. NUMBER OF ENTRIES

Two entries per child.

6. PUBLICITY

By entering work into the competition and exhibition, all artists thereby agree to allow images of their work to be used for exhibition and competition promotion via our website, posters and social media.

7. ENTRY FORM

All entries submitted must be on the official entry form, with artist's full name and address or school attended, and with date of birth (for 18 and under), title and medium of entry and sale prices if pictures are for sale.

8. LABELLING

Each entry must be signed by the artist, and clearly labelled on the back with the name and address of the artist, title, medium and sale price of the picture (if applicable). Abstract works must clearly indicate which way up they are to be hung.

9. DELIVERY

Entries must be delivered to Wiltshire Museum with completed entry form and entrance fee during normal opening hours from 23 to 28 September 2024 (check times at: www.wiltshiremuseum.org.uk).

10. SELECTION OF WORKS

All entries will be judged and the decision of the judges is final. Judging will take place on Wednesday 2 October 2024.

11. PRIZE GIVING

Prize winners will be notified after 11th and before 18th October 2024. Prize giving is on Sunday 20 October 2024.

12. EXHIBITION

Runs from 19 October until 23 November 2024. We will display a selection of all entries received. No entry shall be removed before the close of the exhibition.

13. SALE OF ENTRIES

All entries offered for sale are subject to the Society's 30% commission (plus VAT).

14. CARE OF ENTRIES

Whilst every care will be taken during selection, hanging and exhibition, the Museum wishes to make it clear that it will not be liable for any loss or damage.
